- A1 Membership is on an annual basis, and renews on 1 January each year.
- A2 Standard terms are for members to pay their subscriptions, or for the REA to have received a completed direct debit mandate, within 30 days of renewal. Failure to comply with standard terms will incur a 15% surcharge.
- A3 A 5% discount will be automatically applied for members with whom we hold a direct debit mandate at renewal and also to members who pay their annual renewal fees early by any other method i.e. before renewal date.
- A4 Members may opt to pay the annual fee in monthly instalments. This must be by direct debit and an administration fee of 5% of the annual fee will be added to the first payment collected.
- A5 All fees exclude VAT, which will be added at the prevailing rate.
- A6 Corporate membership categories are determined by reference to the higher of either annual turnover or number of employees as indicated in the table above.
- A7 Under the REA by-laws, installers of domestic microgeneration systems who wish to join the REA must also join the REAL Assurance Scheme (www.realassurance.org.uk). Companies with fewer than 7 employees, and with an annual turnover of less than £500k, who are already a member of REAL, or who join REAL simultaneously, can enjoy full REA benefits for this very low fee.
- A8 Any member may terminate membership of the association by serving notice in writing to the head office no less than three months before the end of any membership year. No refunds will be made in respect of any subscriptions previously paid.
- A9 Overseas members, with no staff or premises in the UK, are entitled to a 50% discount.
- A10 Members agree to adhere to the bye-laws, which may be viewed on the association's website.
