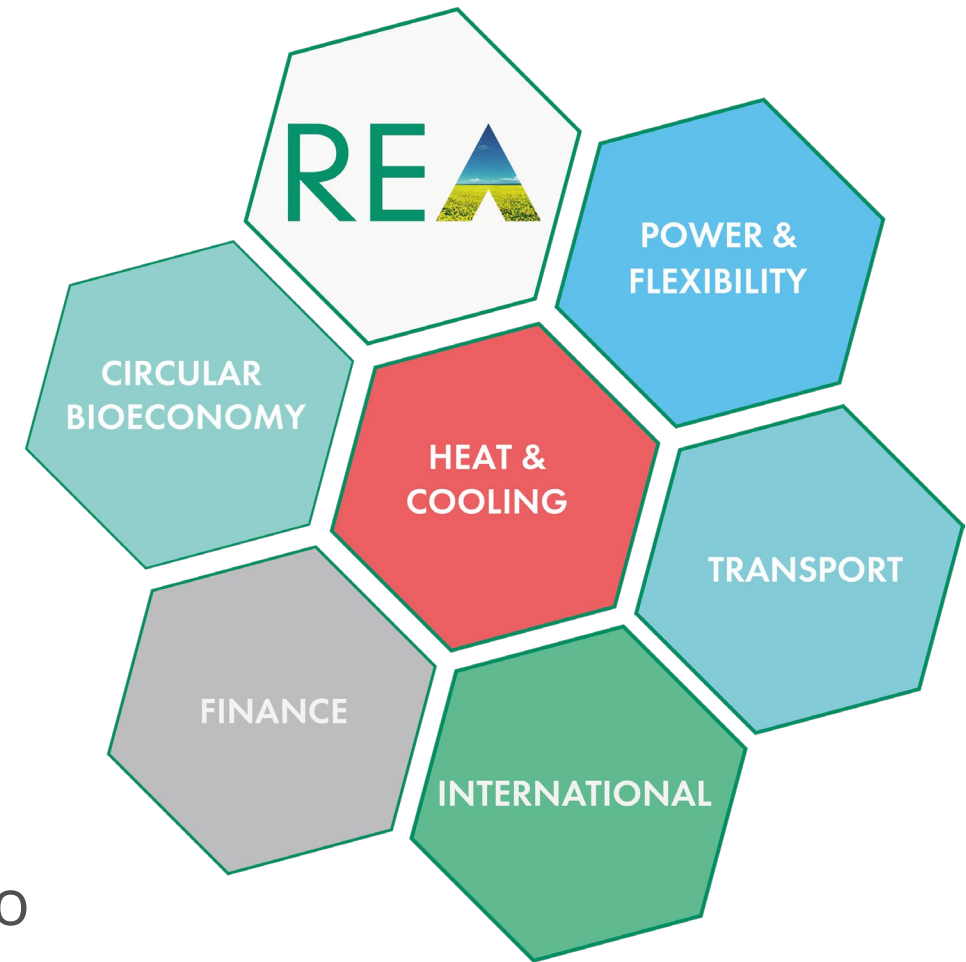


REA's Strategic Pillars

What is The REA



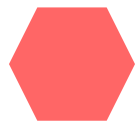

Members can join the various Forums and Working Groups focused on individual renewable technologies, energy market sectors, or cross-cutting issues.



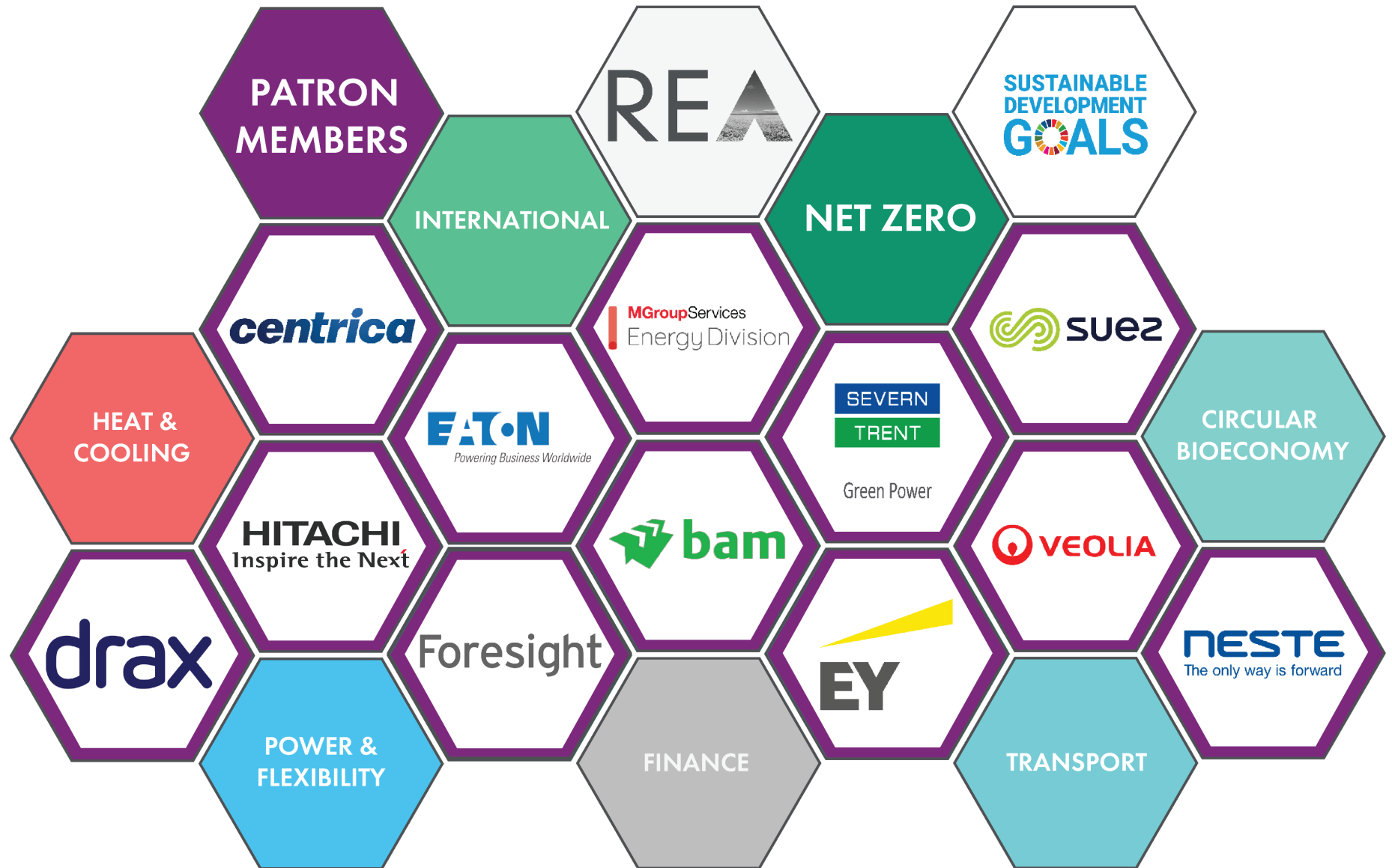
The REA operates on a one-member-one vote basis, creating an environment where all member voices are heard, and companies are encouraged to work together to find policy solutions and form positions.

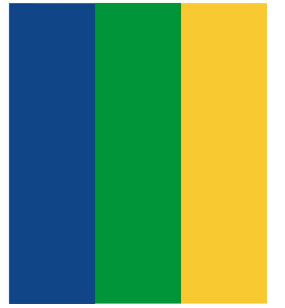

It will include the 30th session of the Conference of the Parties (COP 30), the 20th meeting of the COP serving as the Meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP 20), and the seventh meeting of the COP serving as the Meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA 7).
